All set to take place at Stadium Negara, Kuala Lumpur on Feb 25, Tiger presents Muse World Tour 2007 is set to go down as one of Tiger's most bold and phenomenal music ventures to date, leaving the local 'live' music scene nodding in approval and brimming with anticipation of the next big one.

Muse, comprising of Matthew Bellamy on guitar, keyboard and vocals, Dominic Howard on drums and



percussion, and Chris Wolstenholme on bass and backing vocals, has plenty of fans in Malaysia. Its fourth album *Black Holes and Revelations* has already yielded two sizzling radio hits: *Supermassive Black Hole* and *Starlight*.
